THE MONROE FOUNDATION'S CHICAGO MEETING WITH FIFTH THIRD BANK TO DISCUSS \$30 BILLION PLAN...A SUCCESS!

THE MONROE FOUNDATION convening partners of the **P.A.C.T. Project** (Partnership Assisting Community Transformation), held an interactive and engaging dialogue with **James Gilliam**, vice president for Corporate Responsibility and **Nicole Johnson-Scales**, senior vice president and market manager, both with Fifth Third Bank, to learn about the recently announced \$30 Billion Community and Economic Development commitment.

Facilitated by the Monroe Foundation, several partners engaged in creating affordable jobs through economic opportunities, and redevelopment, totaling almost \$10 million, the dialogue was presented to the representatives of the institution as a beginning discussion point for how to implement this commitment.

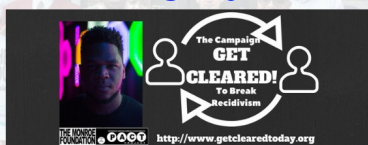
