Halsted and his talented team of professional barbers and hair stylists; and information from **Get Cleared, Chicago** advocates, the **North Lawndale Employment Network** and **Say 'Yes' to Life**, on obtaining their "Rap Sheet" from the Chicago Police Department on 'Rap Sheet Day', August 7th, and a CityKey ID card on August 6th.

Visiting the activity was **Clerk of the Circuit Court Dorothy Brown**, who shook hands and encouraged individuals to work with the consortium to change their lives, along with **17th Ward Alderman David Moore**.

The **Get Cleared, Chicago** summer project is funded by the **Chicago Fund for Safe & Peaceful Chicago**. The re-entry workforce project, set for August 6th at the 006th District Chicago Police Department, is funded by grants from **PNC BANK** and **usbank**.
